Winemaker Notes

This Roble is an excellent introduction to the range, packed with crunchy red fruits & bright acidity

Vineyard

Bela is produced from hand harvested, carefully selected grapes from our own vineyards situated at more than 800m altitude in the village of Villalba de Duero. The soils are calcareous clay and sandy loam and the climate here is continental.

Winemaking

The wine making process is traditional, with prefermentation cold maceration in stainless steel tanks, and, following fermentation, six months ageing in American and French, new and one-year old oak barrels.

Vintage

The 2020 campaign has been marked by a greater volume of rainfall as well as slightly lower temperatures than in other years, leading to fresher wines. In a key stage such as ripening, both the slightly lower temperatures and the rainfall helped us to make it longer, giving rise to a calm and gradual grape harvest, being able to make a good selection of the grapes both in the field and in the winery. The harvest took place in Bela between September, 26th and October, 19th.
