Winemaker Notes

The 2021 Brut Cuvée is a very focused and elegant wine displaying lovely notes of lemon zest, ripe pear, petrichor, and a hint of brioche. On the palate this wine reveals nuances of white nectarine, fresh apple pie, lemon meringue, and crème brûlée that complement the notes from the nose.

Winemaking

This Domaine Carneros Brut Cuvée represents the best of Carneros Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, crafted using exacting méthode traditionnelle standards and aged a minimum of three years.

Vintage

The 2021 growing season commenced with an early bud break followed by unseasonably cool spring and early summer temperatures, which helped preserve vineyard health as we entered a second year of drought conditions. Summer temperatures were moderated by the marine layer which allowed the grapes to mature slowly and consistently and resulted in wonderful depth of flavour and concentration in the generous harvest.
