Winemaker Notes

A Fresh and fruity wine, obtained from a variety of wine batches that ensure quality and consistency. Bright ruby in colour, with a bouquet of young fruit and vibrant aromas of forest fruits. Elegant and smooth with fine tannins on the palate.

Vineyard

Warm temperatures continued throughout the harvest period, but the grapes arrived with excellent quality and with moderate sugar levels.

Winemaking

Destemming, crushing, fermentation temperature control in stainless steel tanks, pneumatic pressing, malolactic fermentation, four months in stainless steel tanks.

Vintage

The agricultural year 2020 registered temperatures slightly higher than the average of the last 21 years, while the precipitation values were identical to the values registered in the same period. With a mild an rainy winter and spring, there was a good restoration of the water reserves of the vineyard, which translated into a good vegetative growth in relation to 2019. The summer was very hot and dry, with very high temperatures in July, which translated in anticipation of the



harvest in about 2 weeks compared to the previous year. The climatic conditions recorded during the painter-maturation period favored gradual maturation, which allowed for a selective harvest favoring the expression and quality of each variety.
