Vineyard

From 80-year old, ungrafted vines planted on sandy soils.

Winemaking

Partially destemmed and fermented with wild yeasts in amphorae lined with resin. The wines were kept in contact with the wine pulp until late November. Naturally occuring malolactic fermentation was followed by basket press.
