# Cherubino Frankland River Shiraz 2020 6x75cl

## Winemaker Notes

A bouquet of spices, crushed herbs, red berries and spicy oak. The palate has youthful and intense flavours of savoury plum, cherry and earthy tannins.

## Winemaking

The fruit was hand harvested and transported to the winery where it was cooled overnight and hand sorted. Maceration lasted for six weeks with minimal pump overs and temperatures ranging for 12-27C. The wine was pressed to tank and allowed to settle for 7

## Vintage

An exceptional vintage with rainfall in just the right times, Shiraz from Frankland is exceptional with tannin and colour. Chardonnay and Pinoy from the sub-region of Porongurup are exceptional examples.
