Winemaker Notes

Côte de Nuits Villages Le Vaucrain is silky and shows a nice colour. The tannins are elegant. When it is young it has aromas of little red berries and liquorice.

Vineyard

The Louis Jadot Le Vaucrain vineyard of 35 hectares was acquired 1996. It is located in Comblanchien, next to the famous Nuits-Saint-Georges Premier Cru Clos de la Maréchale.

Winemaking

The alcoholic fermentation usually lasts 3 to 4 weeks. Ageing takes place in French oak barrels for 10 to 12 months before bottling.

Perfect with roasted game or mushroom quiche.
