Winemaker Notes

An expressive and complex wine with aromas of very ripe black fruits (elderberry & blackberry) along with some spicy scents (pepper & Garrigue). Vineyard

Grapes are hand-harvested, the Grenache is grown on gneiss soil & the syrah on calcareous clay.
