Winemaker Notes

This dry and thirst-quenching Rosé with delicate and refreshing aromas of red fruits is best served chilled and enjoyed immediately.

Vineyard

There are over 12,000 species of wildflowers that grow in Western Australia, over half of which cannot be found anywhere else on earth. The native bush surrounding our vineyards abounds with these vivid blooms providing a distinctive wine landscape like no other.

Winemaking

Just like the region's flora, this wine is distinctively Western Australian – Made from Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

Vintage

The 2024 growing season presented a mix of favourable conditions for wine grape production, characterised by a cool, wet spring followed by a warm and dry summer. Spring began with cooler-than-average temperatures.
