Winemaker Notes

The Blush Sauvignon reveals vibrant aromas of passionfruit and fresh herbs, with a splash of Merlot and Pinot Noir adding floral blossom and delicatated red berry notes.

Vineyard

The cool climate within New Zealand's wine-growing regions provides freshness and natural acidity. Grapes were harvested at moderate sugar levels to retain freshness, with excellent flavours and intensity.

Winemaking

Parcels were crushed, pressed and the juice settled bright prior to being racked and inoculated to ferment at cool temperatures in stainless steel tanks.

Vintage

The 2024 season was warm across key wine growing regions with frequent summer rain keeping the vines healthy. The ripening season was dry, providing excellent fruit flavour and balance.

Food match

Perfect as an aperitif or with fresh alfresco fare.
