2013 Vintage Report





The 2013 harvest in Rioja characterizes for being the latest harvest of this century due to the delay in the evolution of the vineyard.

The harvest started on the 30th of September at CVNE, after a spring with low temperatures and high precipitations. Summer was shorter than usual. The harvest started with a previous selection in the vineyard. The good temperatures of October helped to achieve a good evolution of those vineyards which had been punished by the adverse weather of the rest of the year.

The harvest finished on the 31st of October with hopes of achieving quality wine for this vintage.

In the whole of Rioja a total of 368,3 million kilos of grapes where harvested, of which 342,5 have been red grape and 25,8 white grape.
